

RV Set-Up Checklist



\checkmark	TASK:

RV Set-Up Example Checklist

Exterior

GOAL - Get out and Look
Verify power at pedestal is working properly
Check distance of hookups
Make sure there's no hazards or obstructions

Ensure slide-outs and awning will clear obstacles

Level unit side to side

Chock Tires

Place support blocks under tongue jack

Unhook / disconnect trailer from tow vehicle

Level front to back

Place support blocks under stabilizer jacks

Connect shore power

Connect water lines

Connect sewer hose

Turn on propane

Set up campsite

Set up campsite

Lower Entry steps

Interior

Extend slide-outs

Turn on RV fridge

Turn on A/C or heat

Open Roof Vents

Light Pilot on the oven

Release air in hot water heater, then turn it on

Test water lines

Unpack any secure items

\checkmark	TASK:

RV Tear-Down Example Checklist

\checkmark	Interior
	Pack away loose items
	Secure and lock cabinets, drawers, shower, and windows
	Secure Furniture
	Turn off all electronics
	Turn off water heater and pump, then drain it
	Extinguish pilot light on oven
	Turn off A/C or heat
	Close and secure roof vents
	Turn off fridge or set it to transit mode
	Leave a little water in the toilet to keep seal lubricated and odors out
	Clear off debris on top of slide-outs and any interior obstacles, then retract them

Exterior

Put away all camping furniture
Retract and secure awning
Dump and flush black and grey tanks (only full hookup sites)
Disconnect, drain, and store all water hoses
Unplug from shore power
Turn off propane
Retract Stabilizing jacks
Hitch up tow vehicle and attach power, safety chains, breakaway cables
Test trailer lights
Remove and store leveling blocks and wheel chocks
Raise entry steps
Close and lock entry door and any exterior compartment doors
Check tire pressure
Walk around campsite to ensure all is picked up
Ensure all family members and pets are accounted for
